

Significantly impacting children from an early age through the teen years! We are building programs and relationships to keep our Kids and Teens active and engaged.




■ 5-8 yrs ■ 9-11 yrs ■ 12-14 yrs ■ 15-18 yrs





### **FUNDING SOURCES**



### Yearly Budget - \$1.245 Million

Change a child's life by providing a safe positive place for them to go after-school where maximum impact can be made!

\$40 - Gives a scholarship to 1 child for 1 month of afterschool dues

\$60 - Gives a scholarship to 1 child for 1 week of summer dues

\$170 - Covers costs for 1 month of afterschool care for 1 child

\$250 - Pays for fuel for 1 van per month

\$500 - Pays to heat or cool 1 club for 1 month

\$540 - Gives a scholarship for 1 child's full summer camp dues

\$1,600 - Covers the cost for 1 child's full year of afterschool care

\$1.245 million - Pays our entire budget for a year.

### **OUR CORE PROGRAMS**

### **CHARACTER & LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT**
